

Things to Bring on the Fall Camping Trip

(Packing List)

In addition to the clothes you wear on Thursday, bring the following: Pack it in a sports bag or soft suitcase. No hard suit cases - Please! You can mark your clothes if you are worried about losing anything. Please limit your packing so you don't bring a bunch of extra stuff... Please don't feel that you need to go out and buy items. This list provides clean clothes for the two days that will meet your child's needs.

Clothes:

1 pr. of jeans or pants
2 short sleeve shirts
1 long sleeve shirt & 1 pr. shorts
2 prs. cotton socks
2 prs. under wear
1 warm jacket
1 rain coat or poncho
1 swim suit (we will swim) and life vest
sturdy shoes or
comfortable hiking boots

Sleeping and Personal Needs:

sleeping bag
pillow (if wanted)
towel and soap
toothbrush and paste & personal hygiene items
flashlight
camera and film
day hiking pack (like a school backpack just to carry things you need)
two pencils
camp chair

Optional Clothes: (Good idea)

sweaters or sweatshirt
pajamas or sweat suit
hat
gloves (for warmth)

Please leave the following at home:

knives, guns, weapons
walkmans, CDs, iPods,
cell phones (No reception)
electronic games of all types
extra food (We don't want mice or
other critters joining us)
***Note** If you use your iPod touch or cell phone
as a camera you may bring it but it will not be used
for music, games, phone calls, or texting outside of
the car during the trip.
